We function under the leadership of Dr. Nathaniel Dunlap, Jr., Executive Director, who manages the day to day operational, academic and ministerial affairs. Volunteers serve the organization with administrative and logistical functions (set-up, coordination, registration, etc.). Also, Interns from various educational institutions around the country gain valuable real-time experience while preparing for the workforce. We secured our 501(c)(3) status in May 2015.

We will also launch our **Bankruptcy Assistance initiative** through the U.S. Bankruptcy Court by Fall 2020.
